

**SUPLA (Sullivan Public Library Alliance)
Library-by-Mail Delivery Application**

Who is Eligible? Library-by-Mail delivery service is available for free to residents of Sullivan County who are temporarily or permanently homebound due to illness, disability, immobility or transportation issues. While this is a free service, you will need a library card from your home library. Registration forms for new library cards can be obtained from the patron's home library via mail, email, or fax upon request.

How does the service work? Once you have completed the application process and your reading interest form, you will be mailed up to 4 items at a time, including a return postage label in the designated mail bag which you will be allowed to use for up to 28 days. You will be responsible for returning the bag and items in that time period. Additional items will be mailed after the previous shipment is returned.
